As we are a designated zoo we have detailed and thorough inspections every three years from the West Somerset Council and from a Defra appointed veterinary inspector. Our recent inspection was carried out in May 2011. We are delighted to have received an outstanding report from our recent Zoo Inspection, which we would like to share with you 😊

*The Inspectors wish to congratulate the proprietors on the attractive, friendly and varied nature of the Owl and Hawk Centre. The birds were being kept in very clean environments, and were in very good health. The surrounding farm buildings are of great interest. There is a range of activities for visitors to undertake.
